Iowa Heart Foundation - 2011 Year in Review

Programming Initiatives

Professional Education

- 20th Annual Cardiovascular Today Conference (February). This conference is designed for Physicians, Physician Assistants, Nurse Practitioners, Registered Nurses and healthcare professionals. Over 360 attended the program aimed at increasing knowledge on current cardiovascular research, diagnosis, and treatment.
- Community Wellness Programming Heart health programs provided to Des Moines Area Community College (DMACC) dental assistant students and Mercy College of Health Sciences faculty and staff.
- Childhood Obesity Prevention (COP) Project partnered with Albia, Chariton, Jefferson-Scranton, Seymour, Urbandale, and Waukee Community Schools for classroom/nutrition education display sessions and blood pressure screenings. 600 students, teachers and parents attended COP sessions.
- Pharmaceutical Forums (monthly). Iowa Heart Center physicians/staff attend forums on emerging research and patient information on pharmaceuticals and devices.

Charitable Healthcare Services

• Nursing Scholarship Program (July 2011). Awarded two Dr. David and Leticia Gordon Nursing Scholarships totaling \$500 for nursing students attending Grandview University and DMACC. Awarded four nursing scholarships from donors Karen and Craig Hawkins in memory of their parents, Erma M. Hawkins and C. J. Hawkins.

AED Placement Program. Iowa businesses and organizations receiving AEDs/ funding include: Lucas County Health Center; Hope United Methodist Church, Marshalltown, Iowa; and Vrendenburg-Chariton Aquatic Center.



Iowa Heart Foundation donated two Automatic External Defibrillators (AEDs) this quarter in Iowa communities. Since the AED Placement Program began in Fall 2008, funding for 14 AED placements throughout Iowa has been generated during the Run For Your Life event held annually in August.

AED donations this quarter include Hope United Methodist Church in Marshalltown Iowa on 9-30-11. Bill Martin accepted the donation on behalf of the church. John Peterson from the Vrendenburg-Chariton Aquatic Center in Chariton Iowa accepted the donated AED on 11-8-11. AEDs are important links in the chain of survival in the event of a sudden cardiac arrest.




