AED Device Placement















Iowa Heart Foundation donated one Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) this quarter in Iowa communities. Since the AED Placement Program began in Fall 2008, funding for 21 AED placements throughout Iowa has been generated during the Run For Your Life event held annually in August.

An AED was placed this quarter at the Des Moines Metro Ice Arena/Des Moines Figure Skating Club on October 6, 2012. Brett Kaszinksi accepted the donation on behalf of the skating club and ice arena. AEDs are important links in the chain of survival in the event of a sudden cardiac arrest. 


